## OC Health Care Agency Emergency Medical Services HIE + EMS Project Executive Summary



### Background:

#### Transition from Paper to Electronic Systems:

Emergency Medical Services (EMS) have been consistently provided to communities throughout California for the last several decades. EMS responders are mandated by California regulations and local policy to complete a Patient Care Report (PCR) whenever they make contact with a patient to document incident demographics, assessments, and treatments. Historically, the PCR was completed on a paper form and a carbon copy was hand delivered to the receiving hospital emergency department. While the paper PCR included a significant amount of information relevant to emergency patient assessments and care, it was often illegible and it was nearly impossible to extract data for prospective or retrospective analysis of the quality of patient care.
